02 | INSTITUTIONAL REFORMS & DIGITAL GOVERNANCE

2.1 E-Governance Systems

- Deployment of electronic personnel files (E-Files) for civil servants, integrated with payroll and nominal rolls following a comprehensive verification exercise.
- Official emails created for Executive Council Members and all senior civil servants across the State for e-government communication and service delivery
- Biometric attendance system in select MDAs to enhance accountability and workforce efficiency.
- Development of a Visitor Management System (VMS) at Government House for automated and secure access control.

2.2 Executive Council Digitization

- Development and deployment of the E-Govt Platform, a dedicated E-government solution for Executive Council members, enabling:
 - Paperless meetings
 - Digital memo processing
 - Decision tracking
 - Secure archiving of resolutions
- Full automation of the State Executive Council Chamber with modern digital conferencing and ICT facilities
- Full automation of the State House of Assembly Chamber with modern digital conferencing and ICT facilities.




4.1 Student Data Verification & Fraud Prevention System (NECO & WAEC)

5.2 Establishment of the Zamfara Institute of Information Technology (ZIIT)

Following passage of the enabling bill by the State House of Assembly in October 2025. The institute is envisioned as a world-class ICT education and innovation hub.

5.3 Women & Youth Empowerment

NCC-ZITDA Women Digital Skills Program: 150 women trained, each receiving an Android device, certification, and ₦100,000 startup grant and special package for the best 10 performing students.

Oracle-ZITDA Skills Initiative: Over 3,000 Zamfara youths trained in cloud computing, AI, cybersecurity, and database technologies.

Oracle Academy Capacity Building for faculty and students in tertiary institutions across the state



5.4 Institutional Capacity Building

01 Training of Executive Council Members on basic computer operations and Microsoft Office tools to strengthen digital readiness.

02 Training of 30 Fellows for a 12-month internship Programme under the Nigeria Jubilee Fellowship in collaboration with the UNDP, covering digital skills, administrative operations, and office management.

03 Experience AI Workshop (Phase I & Phase II):
ZITDA, in collaboration with WOMEN in TECH organized Experience AI Workshops aimed at introducing artificial intelligence concepts at the public secondary school level.

Phase I: 20 secondary school students and 5 teachers

Phase II: 20 secondary school students and 5 teachers

The workshops focused on foundational AI knowledge, ethical AI use, and practical exposure, strengthening early-stage digital and AI awareness among students and educators.






